- The first 10 amendments

1st Amendment → 5 rights

① Freedom of Speech

- freedom of expression
- NOT just speech
- clothing, music, art

② Freedom of Religion

- No official religion in United States

- Ⓐ You can follow any religion
- Ⓑ Not forced to follow one

③ Freedom of Press

- newspaper, TV, internet
- government can't censor or ban critics
- Purpose is to encourage free thinking.

④ Assembly

- The right to gather/meet in public
- Protest / peaceful

⑤ Petition

- written protest of the government
