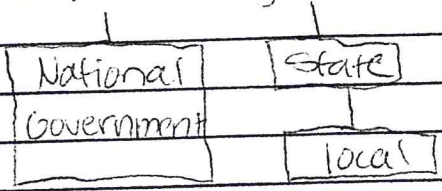

Class Notes: Federal System



The US has a federal system, in this type of system power is shared but national is supreme.

\*Other Systems

<u>Confederal</u>	<u>Unitary</u>
Power is shared but state is supreme	No sharing national is supreme

Types of Government

Democracy - a government where people have the power. (is based on majority rule)

<u>Direct Democracy</u>	<u>Representative Democracy</u>	<u>Constitutional Monarchy</u>
Citizens vote on all issues	Citizens elect people to make laws and govern	Country has a King, but people vote for leaders
